3. Paste the link onto the URL address
4. If you cannot see the page, go to google.com and click on maps
5. Search for Golden Gate Park Scenery Tour
6. Click on the name of the tour again to see the map and print it out

Transportation:

-This tour is completely all walking

-The Tour Starts at the Rose Garden at the corner of Park Presidio and Fulton.

-Then on the left side of the screen there will be a link that says get directions click on that.

-A box will open up

-Type in your current address and choose a mood of transportation (car, walk, or public transportation; MUNI)

-The MUNI bus (San Francisco's public transportation system) costs are \$0.50 for children under 17 and Seniors and \$1.50 for Adults. BRING EXACT CHANGE!

-Keep your transfers! They can allow you to get on to public transportation within 3 hours of receiving the transfer

-Feel free to ask the driver for directions, they will help you.

-To get off the back of the bus you must step down and push the bars when the over head light turns green. If the doors do not open, yell; back door at the bus driver and they will know to open the door.

Money:

-You will need around \$3-5 dollars per person for the entrance fee for the Japanese Tea Garden

-For the Academy of Science, you will need around \$25 per adult, \$20 per senior, \$15 children ages 7-11 and children under 6 are free.

-For the deYoung Museum, you will need \$10 per adult, \$7 per senior, \$6 for students and children under 13 are free.

-Bring around \$50 dollars if you wish to buy souvenirs from gift shops and more for money for food. Most places will except credit cards.

Tips:

-It is recommended that you check the weather on the day you plan to take the tour. As the Golden Gate Park is located between the Richmond and Sunset District, which are the coldest districts in San Francisco, it may get chilly.

-You may check by going to weather.com

-Also, you can bring some food and have a picnic or buy food at a small stall half way through.

-Wear comfortable shoes and please don't go if pregnant or have a hard time walking, there is a lot of walking.

Download your audio:

- Please click on Audio Tours of San Francisco located at the top of the page
- Search for Golden Gate Park Scenery Tour
- Right click on the link and then click "Save link as"
- Save it into your computer and you may import it into Itunes or other MP3 players
- Sync Itunes or other MP3 players so the audio is in your music device
- You may need to pause your music device several times to find directions of which streets and pathways
